

## INTRODUCTION TO LAW ACTIVITY

### Ring Game

#### OBJECTIVE:

To help develop a definition for law, an appreciation for the necessity and purpose of rules, and some basic ideas as to fairness.

#### RULES OF PLAY:

1. Each row of students will be provided with one paper clip.
2. The objective of the game is to pass the paper clip from student to student to the end of the row, then back to the beginning. The first row to complete this objective is the winner.
3. All males must always pass the paper clip with their left hands, subject to any rules below.
4. Any student with blond hair must repeat the phrase "due process of law" as they pass the paper clip.
5. The paper clip must never be set on a desk-top or dropped on the floor. Any team which does so must return the paper clip to the front of the row and begin again.
6. When a row completes the passing of the paper clip from front to back and back to front, the student at the front of the row must stand and say "I surrender" within 10 seconds to win the game.
